1.1. PIRAN

The old seaport of Piran lies at the end of the Piran peninsula, which gradually narrows between the bays of Strunjan and Piran. The peninsula reaches Cape Madona, ending with the Šavrini hills. The meaning of the name Piran: elder scientists support the supposition that the origin could derive from the Celtic word bior-dun, supposed to mean a settlement on the hill, while younger generation advocates the explanation of the Greek word pyr – fire, as the original settlement was primarily used as a lighthouse for vessels sailing to nearby Greek colony Aegida on the site of today town Koper.

The town has preserved the medieval layout with narrow streets and compact houses, which rise in steps from the coastal lowland into the hills and give the whole area a typical Mediterranean look.

2.4. EVENT CENTRE

Event centre is situated at EPICENTER. Please follow signs from Tartini square.

Working hours (registration): 11h-14h

We kindly ask club representatives to come on time.

Working hours (WC, dressing room): 11h-19h.

In Epicenter will be also possible to change your clothes and use toilettes. From 15.20h till the end of last start in MW21E category will not be possible to enter or to stay in EPICENTER.



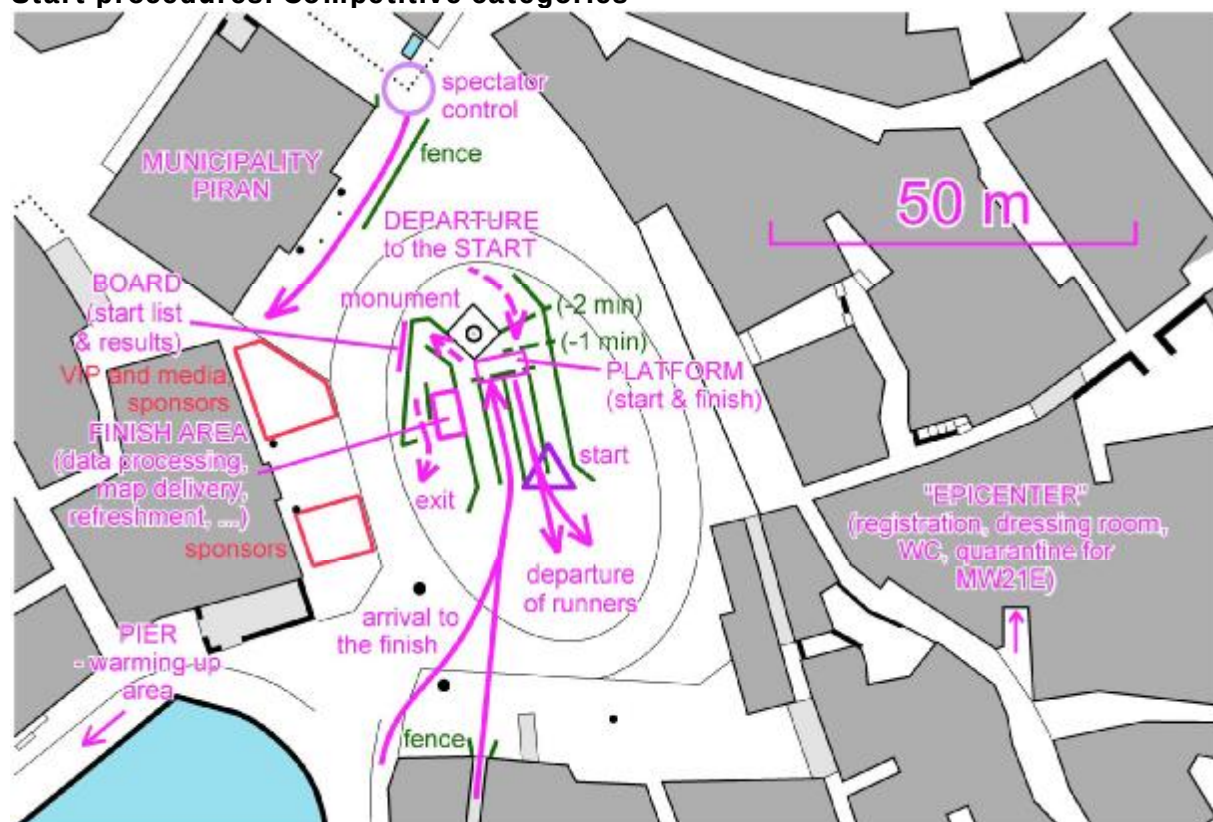
2.5. FREE AREAS FOR COMPETITORS

When you will enter the PIRAN city you may use only streets which are leading to Tartini square and EVENT CENTRE (marked route). At Tartini square will be signs for warm-up area. This will be the only one free-area for all competitors after you will be in PIRAN. Any kind of violation of this rule may lead to disqualification.

2.6. START - FINISH ARENA

Start and finish line (corridor) will be separated for competitive and non-competitive categories. At finish area you must return bib-numbers and Sicard. All runners must put maps in club bags in finish area. Maps will be given back cca. at 18.00 p.m.

2.7. WARM - UP AREA

Warm-up area for all categories is at south west pier from Tartini square. Please follow signs from Tartini square. Athletes may use only Tartini square and south west pier to prepare for the race.

2.8. NUMBER BIBS

All athletes must have number bibs clearly visible on their chest. At Finish area number bibs must be returned. Numbers bibs are different color for competitive categories (yellow) and non-competitive categories (blue).

2.9. MAPS & CONTROL DESCRIPTIONS

It is forbidden to possess or use of any other maps of PIRAN when you will enter in PIRAN city (WRE rule). Organizer may disqualify runners who will not pay attention on this rule or fair-play of the competition.

Control descriptions will be hand over to runners in first starting box (-2).

2.11. START PROCEDURES

Start procedures for ELITE are different.

Runners from other categories enter in corridor box -2 min before their start time. Runners will be called by their name. The competitors have to identify themselves with number bibs on the chest and SI card number will be checked. Starting interval is 1 minute. Be careful on your start time. ZERO START IS 13.00h.

2.12. TRAFFIC IN PIRAN

In PIRAN are also some small areas which are open only for local transport. You must be careful when you cross the streets. Main road is not close for the traffic.

2.13. PARKING

Parking areas are outside PIRAN. Two nearest parking places are:

P1 - Parking house: 150 SIT/hour

P2 - FORNAČE: 180 SIT/hour

Hotel Bernardin parking area: free parking place (very hard to find free place)



You could also park in Portorož and come by local mini bus to PIRAN.

3. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MW21 ELITE

We ask Elite runners to follow instructions from organizer as we would like to promote Orienteering in the best possible way.

3.1. ELITE RUNNERS PRESENTATION

Organizers will prepare list of entered runners. Best 15 M/W runners from WRE list and max. 5 other best runners will be presented at stage before the start of ELITE categories.

Presentation of the best athletes – MW21 ELITE will be at 15.30h on stage. Contact person: Dijana Galjažević.

3.2. START LIST

Start list for ELITE will be based on WRE rank list. 15 best athletes and 5 runners selected by organizer will start last. Start interval is 1 min.

3.3. WARM - UP AREAS

Warm-up area before 13.00h is at south west pier from Tartini square. Before start runners could also use warm-up area in blind alley beside EPICENTER start from 15.30h.

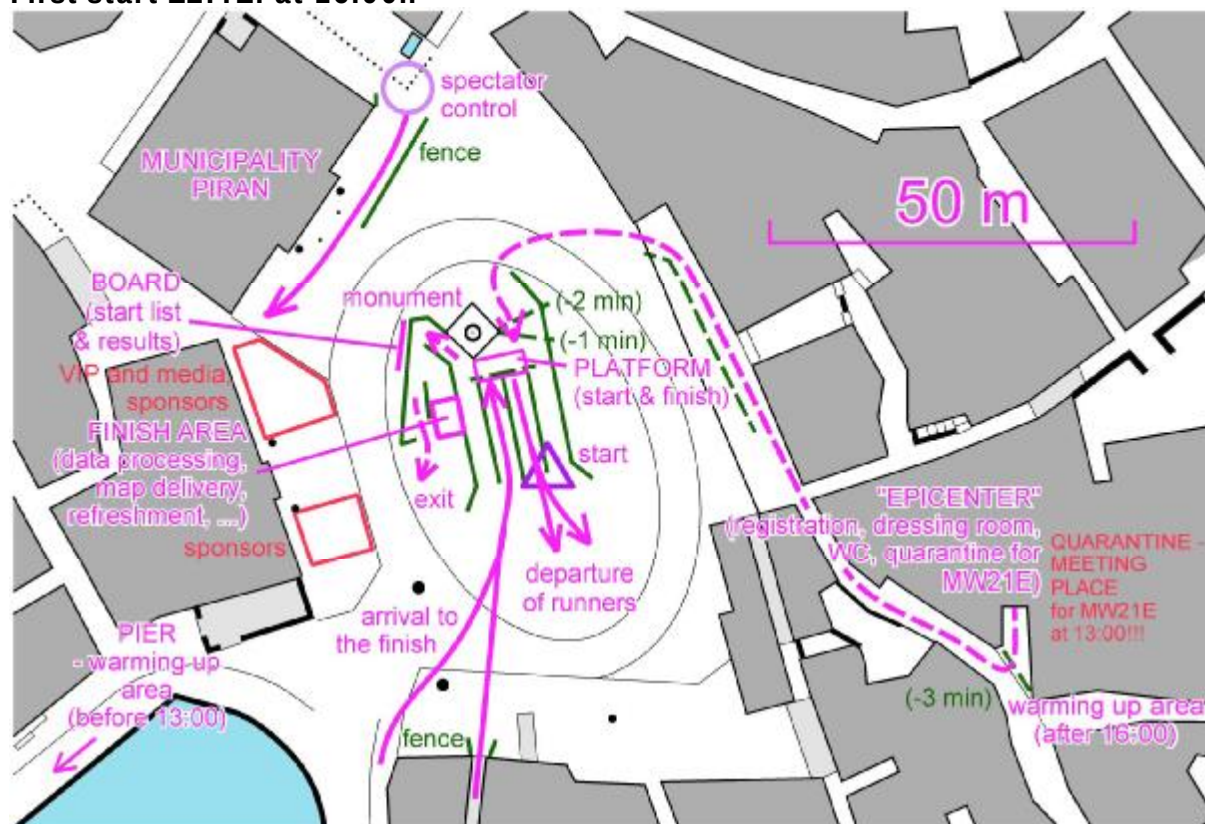
3.4. QUARANTINE AND START PROCEDURES

Quarantine is compulsory for runners in MW21 ELITE. Quarantine meeting point is at Event centre – EPICENTER and start at 13.00h. All runners must register and will get further information about starting procedures and presentation of the best runners in Quarantine. ELITE runners will have separate room.

Quarantine is the only choice for organizer to give same condition to all competitors.

Control descriptions will be hand over to runners in first starting box (-3) before start.
